

Common Fee Structure for various academic programmes for the year 2024-25 received from NCHM, Noida - Approval - Regarding.

The Board noted that NCHMCT vide letter No.NCHM-10104/3/2020/ADMIN, dated 09.11.2023 have given the common fee structure for the academic batch to be admitted in 2024-2025. As per the same institute's in category "A" city have the maximum discretion to charge additionally up to 40% of the basic tuition fee. IHM-Chennai being in this category can also exercise discretion to charge upto 40%. The table showing the increase in tuition fee at various slabs is as under: -
